Regular Meeting Minutes January 22, 2018

President Anthony Alford called to order the Regular Meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at the TLCD office located at 220 Clendenning Road, Houma, Louisiana, 12:00 NOON on January 22, 2018.

Angela Rains led the opening prayer, and Commissioner Henry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Upon roll call by Angela Rains, Commissioners recorded as present were: Alford, Chauvin, Daisy, Henry, Moore, and Walker. Commissioner Cenac is recorded as absent. Commissioner Shaffer is recorded as entering the proceedings at 12:05 P.M.

Under approval of minutes: Motion: Henry, Second: Daisy, to approve the Regular Minutes dated January 8, 2018. The motion passed.

Under Public, there was no one wishing to address the board.

Under Management's Report, there was nothing to report.

Under Executive Director's Report, Mr. Dupre asked the board to adopt Resolution No. 18-001, to enter into an IGA with TPCG to allow use of TLCD's right of entry authority for the Petit Caillou Drainage Project. Motion: Henry, Second: Chauvin. The resolution was adopted.

Philip Chauvin with T. Baker Smith, LLC provided updates on the following projects: TLCD General Services Agreement, and the Reach E Environmental Water Control Structure Project.
